

# Meet discusses research ideas in finance, banking

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**Mysuru:** Centralized financial trading with technology support has reduced the time duration between gain and loss, said professor SSS Kumar, Indian Institute of Management (IIM), Kozhikode.

Speaking during the workshop on 'Empirical research in finance,' organized by Shri Dharmasthala Manjunatheswara Institute for Management Development (SDMIMD) on Thursday, Kumar said that as stock trade is held with less than 100 micro seconds in the country, the fast trading system has opened innovative

opportunities for research oriented solutions, he said.

"Every individual aspires to do a PhD, as all the information is available at their finger tips. But research is not just about placing statistics. The researcher should think out-of-box, identify the problems and find solutions through research," he said.
