

Administrative Training Institute & SDMIMD sign MoU

THE Administrative Training Institute (ATI), Mysuru and Shri Dharmasthala Manjunatheshwara Institute for Management Development (SDMIMD) have signed Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) at ATI Mysuru on Tuesday.

The MoU was signed between V Bhagyalakshmi, KTS Joint Director (Training) from ATI and Dr NR Parasuraman, director from SDMIMD. The MoU has made to design, develop, and conduct training and capacity building programmes on development of infrastructure, Public-Private Partnership (PPP)s, project financing and best international/domestic practices used in the implementation of projects or any other programmes.

Dr Parasuraman said the MoU has opened avenues for joint research publication, case studies, and articles in the above areas of collaboration by the faculty members and trainers from the institutes.

“Government of Karnataka is emphasising on the development of various sectors under Public-Private Partnerships (PPP). This needs significant intervention in areas such as project identification and de-



velopment, strategic planning, project designing, transaction, advisory services, project management studies, policy formulation, capacity building, educational and training of all stakeholders, large scale programme formulation, etc,” he added.

SDMIMD will provide the necessary knowledge, experience (through case studies, caselets, activities) in order to develop the curriculum, documents and course material to conduct training programmes.

ATI will provide all the requisite infrastructure, facilities and administrative support in Mysuru and also provide suitable resource persons with expertise on developing workforce through education, training, research and consultancy for some jointly developed courses and programmes as mutually agreed upon.
