

Global meet on HR begins at SDM-IMD

Mysore: To provide a platform for networking and deliberate the emerging trends in the area of managing human resources (HR), Sri Dharmasthala Manjunatheshwara Institute for Management Development (SDM-IMD) is organizing an international HR conference on 'Managing human resources at the workplace' in its premises. The two-day event began on Friday.

Speaking at the conference, KPMG India Pvt Ltd partner Nischae Suri said: "To do more with less, there should be guiding principles for companies to remain buoyant and competitive."

"Strategy management is a powerful tool for creating organizational effectiveness in the realm of managing HR. There are eight maxims -- innovation, uncertainty, partnership, knowledge, equality, loyalty and employment -- which should form the ba-

sis for creating a meaningful relationship with the stakeholders. This eventually leads to organizational excellence."

Suri also spoke on concepts like cost, compliance, capacity, capability and connectivity to highlight the need for creating better workforce.

Conference chairperson Mousmi Sengupta said: "Today, HR management is confronted with core issues of managing the change in business processes. This aspect of HR management brings to the fore many issues and prospects which needs to be understood, debated and deliberated upon in order to find new solutions to the problems dogging the corporate world".

Around 325 people, including academicians, managers, researchers and management students and 335 experts from the US, Saudi Arabia, Nepal, Bangladesh, Nigeria, Cameroon, Mexico, Indonesia, France, Iran and India are attending the conference.
